

The construction will be undertaken using two-way temporary traffic lights which will be in use 24/7 for the works. There will be a period when the two-way temporary traffic lights will have the junction of Ferry Road closed as well.

At the end, there will be a night-time road closure (20:00-06:00) in place to complete some of the more challenging works – signage will be out nearer the time.

Information for residents and businesses

The works will consist of moving out the 40mph speed limit to allow the new road junction with pavement into the housing development. Also, minor layby, crossing points, drainage, signage and lighting works will be completed.




This closure will be in effect with the two-way lights on Maldon Road for four weeks.
