TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847, SECTION 21

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

WHEREAS the Maldon District Council is satisfied that vehicular traffic, including pedal cycles and pedestrians (where required), on the footpath, street or length of street set out in the Schedule hereto should be prohibited during certain hours on the day specified in the said Schedule by reason that such footpath, street or length of street will be thronged and liable to be obstructed.

AND WHEREAS the said Maldon District Council is empowered by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act, 1847, to make an order prohibiting the use of that footpath, street or length of street by all classes of vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred by the Town Police Clauses Act, 1847, Section 21, and following consultations with the Essex County Police and Highway Authorities, we, the said Maldon District Council **DO HEREBY ORDER** that the use of the footpath, length of footpath, street or length of street as set out in the Schedule hereto by pedestrians and vehicular traffic, including pedal cycles, be prohibited on the days and during the hours specified in the said Schedule.

PROVIDED ALWAYS that the definition of vehicular traffic shall not include emergency vehicles and traffic requiring access to property in the footpath, street or part of street as specified in the said Schedule.
